You may qualify to participate in the EITC Program!

Individuals who pay at least \$3,500 in state income taxes can join a Special Purpose Entity (SPE) and gain full access to the EITC Tax Credits. How often do you have the opportunity to choose how your state tax dollars are spent? Rarely, if ever. **The Educational Improvement Tax Credit program (EITC) is a way to direct tax dollars toward the education of local children.** This program offered by the State of Pennsylvania provides a win-win benefit to those that qualify. This is one of the few opportunities you will ever have to direct your tax dollars to a specific destination. EITC provides the opportunity to receive tax credits equal to 75% of its contribution, and can be increased to 90% tax credit for a two-year commitment to the program.

Special Purpose Entities are organization that allow your funds to pass through to the Neumann Scholarship Foundation (NSF) which accepts EITC scholarship donations for OMPH School, and others in the Diocese of Harrisburg. NSF takes the funds contributed through EITC to grant scholarships to students who attend or want to attend Catholic school.
