Do you offer tuition assistance?

Will my school district bus to OMPH School?

Yes! OMPH School offers convenient busing from eight neighboring school districts! Our students reside not only in the Ephrata SD, but also in Cocalico, Conestoga Valley, Eastern Lancaster County, Pequea Valley, Manheim Central, Manheim Township, and Warwick. Because of our close proximity to New Holland, Lititz, Leola, Narvon, and other towns, these neighboring districts provide busing to and from OMPH School.

Does OMPH prepare students to meet the challenges of the 21st Century?

Yes! We integrate STEM learning and our faith-values across the curriculum. We have a dedicated science lab (LabLearner) onsite as well as a computer lab. Students use various technology including iPads, Chromebooks, and Ozobots. Are students at OMPH required to wear uniforms?
