Mrs. Kim Hoffmann, Preschool teacher at OMPH School, is excited to announce that OMPH has added a very fun and educational component to our Preschool Curriculum: the new and improved Letter People! The Letter People program is a comprehensive, Pre-K curriculum that is research based and has been classroom tested for over 30 years. Letter People uses characters to represent the letters of the alphabet, which helps children develop language and early literacy skills. Each week, the children are introduced to a new letter of the alphabet using a puppet representing that letter. These special "friends" motivate the students to learn and gets them talking, moving, interacting, experimenting, and writing. Most importantly, this gives them a love of learning! The literature in this program uses themes, allowing each area of the curriculum to be reinforced, such as Math, Science, Social Studies and Health. These themes help students to develop, inspire, and grow in knowledge and skills across all subject areas. The Letter People program encourages children to use their imagination, creativity, and thinking skills in a fun and creative way. This will benefit them in all areas of their development, including free play with their classmates, which is such an integral part of their early childhood development. As a certified Reading Specialist, Mrs. Hoffmann is excited to get back to school in the Fall and implement this new program into our curriculum!

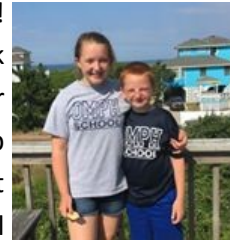
