Guardian Angel Fund:

All gifts received will be directed to the chosen program and a special card will be sent to the donor or honoree.

Blue Jay Fund: The Blue Jay Fund, sponsored by our school benefactors, promotes Catholic education at OMPH by providing tuition assistance to qualifying families. Grants are awarded based on financial need as determined by a review of the fund application, supporting essay and financial documents. Each year 80% of the fund resources are awarded to qualifying families; 20% of the fund are retained for future growth. It is our hope that through your generosity more children will have the opportunity to receive a Catholic education at OMPH School. Donations of \$1000 or more will be recognized on a special *Mary's Children* plaque in the school.

EITC Program Makes a Difference at OMPH School

Did you know your business can make a direct impact on OMPH School students? The EITC/Educational Improvement Tax Credit Program helps your business do just that! If your business pays one or more of these taxes, you qualify for EITC:

- Retaliatory Fees Under Section 21 of the Insurance Law of 1921 (New for 2017)
- Corporate Net Income Tax
- Capital Stock Franchise Tax
- Bank and Trust Company Shares Tax
- Title Insurance Companies Shares Tax
- Malt Beverage Tax
- Insurance Premiums Tax
- Mutual Thrift Institutions Tax
- Pennsylvania Income Tax Liability Tax
